- (b) To establish, support acquire run and/or grant aid and other financial assistance to schools, colleges, libraries reading rooms, hostel, boarding houses, laboratories and other institutions of like nature at any place or places in the Indian Union for use of the students and the staff and also generally for the development and/or **advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public in general.**
- (c) To establish, maintain and/or run studentships, scholarships and render other kind of aid to individuals including supply of medicines, books, stipends, medals and other incentives to study, without any distinction caste, colour or creed.
- (d) To grant aid, to promote, establish, support and/or maintain institution for the promotion of Science Literature, Music, Drama and Fine Arts, for the preservation of old historical monuments and for the research and other institution having similar objects for the benefit of the public in general.
- (e) To grant relief during natural calamities, such as famine, earthquake, flood, fire pestilence and other occasion of calamities of similar nature and to give donations subscriptions or contributions to institutions, establishment or persons during such relief work.
- (f) To render assistance and/or grant aid to other Public Charitable Trusts or institutions related to above said objects.
- (g) To do any other act for the advancement of general public utility related to education not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit, without distinction of caste, colour or creed.
- (4) The Trustees shall cause true and accurate account, to be kept for all money received and spent regarding all matters in respect thereof, in course of management of Trust properties or in relation to the carrying out of the objects and purposes of the Trust, as well as of all assets, credits and effects of the Trust properties.
- (5) For the furtherance of the objects of the trust and in accordance with the provisions of the Income -Tax Act, for the investmet or use of Trust Fund

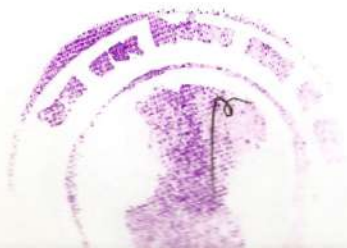

- (8) The trustees are entitled to receive remuneration not more than as prevailing in the market. The Trustees may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the trust or their duties relating thereto.
- (9) The number of the Trustees shall not be less than two and more than seven. If the number of the Trustees shall fall below two, the Trustees shall not, except for the purpose of filling any vacancy, act so long number is below the said minimum.
- (10) The Trustees for the time being will be at liberty to appoint additional Trustee within the number mentioned above, for such period or on such terms as to retirement and re-appointment, as the trustees for the time being consider proper. If any trustee dies, retires, becomes unfit or incapable to act, the continuing or surviving Trustee or Trustees will be competent to appoint a Trustee in place of the Trustees dying, retiring or becoming unfit or incapable to act. A person shall cease to be a Trustee either : (i) if he without leave of absence does not attend three consecutive meetings of the trustees of for lone calendar year, whichever is longer, or (2) if he requested to resign by 3/4th or as near thereto as possible of the remaining Trustees.
- (11) Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.
- (12) The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulation of the meetings of trustees. In the absence of such regulations:-
  - (a) Two Trustees shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustees.
  - (b) All matters will be decided mutually by the Trustees.
  - (c) Resolutions passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of two third of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees.



- (13) The Trustees shall have the power and their uncontrolled discretion, instead of acting personally, to employ and pay an agent (including any Bank) to transact any business or to do any act whatsoever in relation to the Trust of these presents, including the receipt and payment of moneys without being liable for loss, and shall be entitled to be allowed and paid all charges and expenses incurred thereby.
- (14) The Trustees may delegate in writing all or any of his powers under these presents to his nominee, who will be entitled so long as such nomination remains in force, to exercise such power, in the same manner as the Trustee himself could do personally.
- (15) The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any moneys or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoings ought to be paid or borne and on every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorize the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Trust for any purpose not authorized by these presents.
- (16) It shall be lawful for the Trustees to settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim, demand, or things, proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- (17) It shall be lawful for the trustees to borrow moneys either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust Fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents, and it shall be lawful for the Trustees to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- (18) It shall be lawful for the Trustees :
- (a) To apply to the Government, public bodies, urban, local, municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donation, gifts, subscriptions, and other assistance with a view to promoting the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Departments, Public and Other Bodies Corporations, Companies or Persons, Scheme and Other

(19) The Trust shall maintain proper books of account and the account of the Trust shall be closed every year on 31<sup>st</sup> March.

(20) These Trust Funds shall be and remain irrevocable for all times.

(21) The office of the Trust shall be situated at **205, Shashi Complex, Exhibition Road, Patna** unless changed by the Trustees by two-third majority.

(22) It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust property or its income of Trust Fund shall be supplied for any purpose outside India or for any purpose which is not a public charitable purpose in law and all provisions hereof shall be construed accordingly.
